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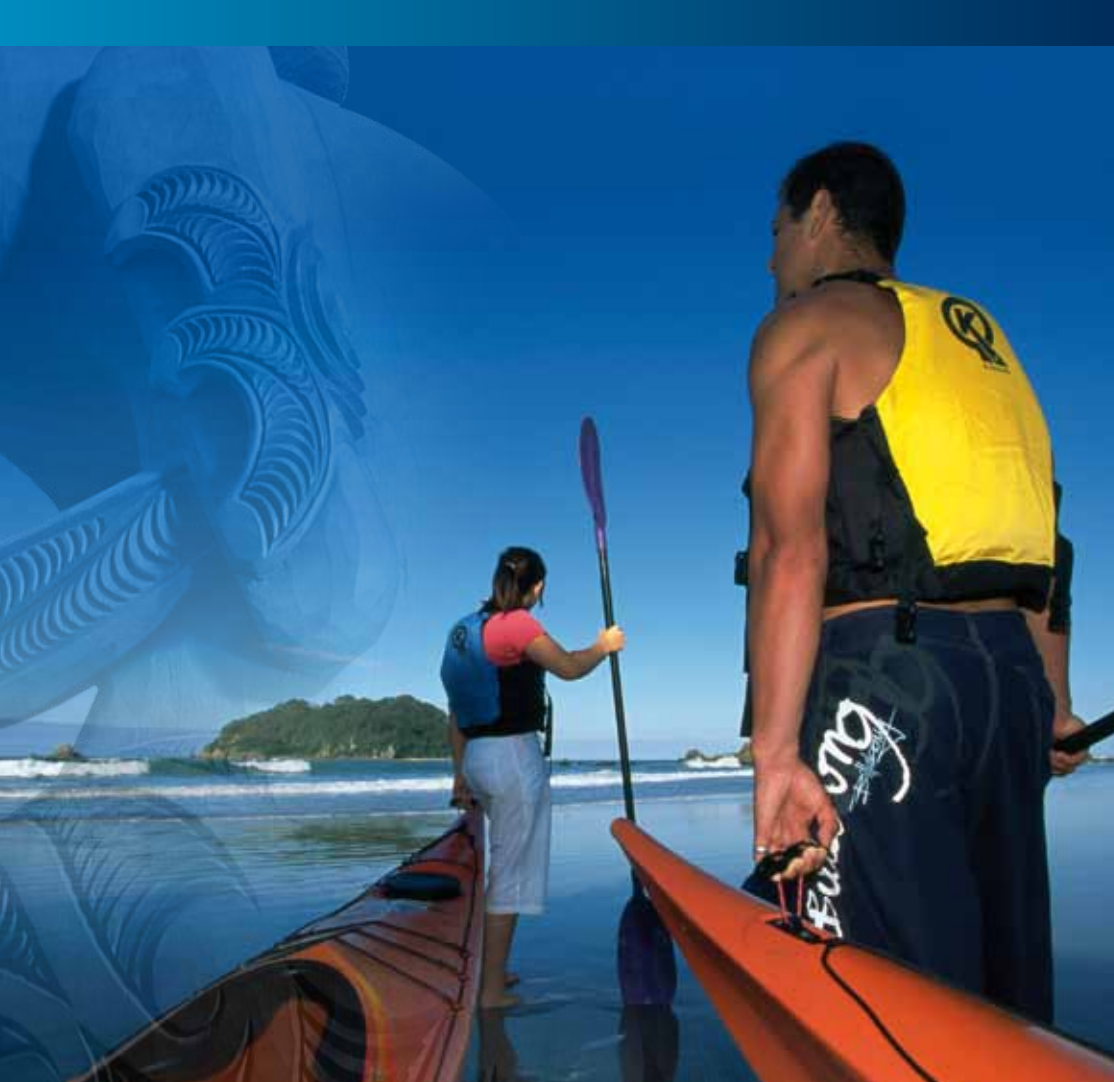

SITE SAFE SUPERVISOR GOLD CARD



Site Safe New Zealand is working with the construction industry to provide safety training. The Site Safe Supervisor Gold Card two day course targets supervisors to help them better manage safety on their projects, and is for those who need a more in-depth knowledge of construction health and safety.

Content

- Effects accidents have on overall costs and profits
- Identification and elimination of risks associated with project hazards and unsafe behaviour
- Planning safety into projects
- Teaching and coaching techniques suitable for use on construction sites
- Proactive steps to manage safety
- Accident investigation
- Emergency planning

Assessment

A written assignment is to be completed within three weeks of completing the two days tuition.

Qualifications Gained

Upon successful completion of the programme you will receive:

- Site Safe Supervisor Gold Card

Entry Criteria

This training is intended for supervisors on construction sites. Further information is available from Site Safe New Zealand, phone 04 499 4052.

SCAFFOLDING



This programme equips people with knowledge to outline the requirements of non-notifiable prefabricated scaffolds in accordance with the approved code of practice for the safe erection and use of scaffolding. It also teaches skills to erect and alter temporary working platforms to the requirements of the Health and Safety in Employment Regulations.

This programme is designed for those who already have competence in on-site erection and dismantling of scaffolding.

Content

This one day programme is a practical assessment of those skills needed to complete unit standard 9184. It is designed to provide training to enable you to safely erect, alter, inspect and dismantle non-notifiable pre-fabricated scaffolding to a maximum of five metres high.

Once enrolled on this one day programme you will receive a theory assessment which you complete. Once you have gained competency in the theory assessment you attend Polytechnic for the practical one day assessment.

Assessment

Theory and practical. See above for more detail.

Qualifications Gained

Upon successful completion of the programme you will gain:

- NZQA unit standard 9184

Entry Criteria

You must have practical experience and be competent in on-site erection and dismantling of scaffolding.
