

Roger Dickie Memorial Scholarship 2011



Background

Roger Dickie was a dedicated tutor at the Bay of Plenty Polytechnic and this scholarship has been made available in his memory, under the sponsorship of the NZ Fishing Industry Guild. The purpose of this scholarship is to assist students from throughout New Zealand with fees and associated expenses whilst completing the Certificate in Maritime and Fishing Technology Level 3 at Bay of Plenty Polytechnic. It is provided as an incentive to students to seek higher qualifications in the fishing industry.

Value

\$1,000.00.

Eligibility

Applications are open to all students who successfully complete the Bay of Plenty Polytechnic Certificate in Maritime and Fishing Technology Level 3 programme. Open to NZ citizens or permanent residents only.

Criteria

The applicant will be required to successfully complete the Certificate in Maritime and Fishing Technology Level 3 and be eligible to graduate before they can be considered for selection. They must also demonstrate throughout their study consistent communication and team work, initiative and leadership attributes as well as responsibility in their actions and high quality assessment work.

Selection Panel

A panel comprising NZ Fishing Industry Guild representatives and Bay of Plenty Polytechnic programme tutors will select the recipient. This selection process will take place after the completion of the programme and once examination results are advised.

If there is more than one successful applicant the scholarship will be shared.

- 4 A written statement outlining your **aspirations for a career** in the fishing industry, the **qualities** you feel you have and what **motivates** you to succeed in the programme and be a **worthy recipient** of the scholarship.
